# TRANSPORTATION SERVICES INC. AIDE JOB DESCRIPTION

## **SUMMARY**

The aide assists the school bus or van driver in safely transporting students to and from school. An aide is needed on bus or van with a student that has an IEP or other special circumstances requiring their assignment.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the behavior of students on the bus or van. Works with driver to maintain safe student environment
- Assist in loading and unloading students. Monitor their ride to and from school
- Assist driver in managing the seating of the students so that everyone is safe and secure
- Basic first aid and attention to injury
- Basic record keeping, and maintain confidentiality of student information.
- Oral and written communication skills
- Follow Health and safety regulations required by company, school district, state or fed
- Follow policy and procedures related to student discipline on vans and buses
- Proper use of two way radio system
- Attend safety meetings

## **EDUCATION & LICENSING REQUIREMENTS**

- Valid PA Driver's License
- High School diploma or equivalent

## REQUIREMENTS

- Tact, patience and courtesy with students, parents and other drivers
- Sitting for extended periods of time
- Hearing and speaking to exchange information
- Reaching, pulling and pushing to open van doors or windows
- Reaching overhead, above the shoulders or horizontally
- Should be in good physical condition to be able to secure wheelchair students (including tie downs) strapping a child into a car seat or booster seat, hooking up a child in a safety vest or fastening a seat belt
- Must check inside vehicle daily, front to back for any children or articles left behind
- Should be physically able to pick up a car seat and either drag or carry a child out of the vehicle in an emergency

## WORKING CONDITIONS

- Working in outdoor environment with seasonal heat and cold or adverse weather
- Exposure to fumes, dust, odors, oil/grease and gases
